#### **New premises**

We, unfortunately, have no further update on our new premises as we are still waiting to hear from the County Council re our preferred site. Our business case for NHS prioritisation of funding is complete to submit, as soon as we have the green light to proceed from the County Council.

### **Personalised Lists**

Following our move to personalised GP lists in April this year, we are pleased that the system is working well, with positive feedback from patients receiving continuity of care from their GP (or their locum GP when on annual leave).

## **Medical Receptionists**

Our receptionists are trained by the GP's to sign post patients for the most appropriate care. They are asked by the GP's to obtain information from patients regarding symptoms and this helps them direct patients to the most appropriate service and prioritise urgent care from us where needed. They have details of other services such as local pharmacies, Minor injury units, Social Prescribers and a new service for musculoskeletal pain called "getUBetter". The Gloucestershire MSK app (powered by getUBetter) is provided free of charge by Gloucestershire CCG for patients registered at Chipping Campden Surgery. It can be accessed on a Smartphone or on the Web, and guides you day-by-day through a sequence of exercises and tips to help you recover from a range of new or recurrent musculoskeletal conditions.
